### **Sunday Reflection: We are God's; we belong to him.**

Our primary allegiance is not to a particular nation, kingdom, or institution, but to God. We belong to him in whose image we are made and whose law is inscribed on our hearts. We must give back to God what is his, thus we give him our love, our first fruits, and our very selves, in union with Christ. **LITURGY OF THE WORD** In the first reading, the Lord says to his anointed, Cyrus ... I have called you by your name. Through Cyrus, all will know there is no God besides the Lord. In the second reading, Paul, Silvanus, and Timothy greet the Thessalonian Church with thanksgiving and affirmation. In the Gospel, Jesus' opponents question him about the lawfulness of paying taxes. Jesus sees their hypocrisy and answers, repay to Caesar what belongs to Caesar and to God what belongs to God.

**A Message from Sacred Heart's Finance Committee:**

Many thanks to those parishioners who have continued to support the Parish throughout 2020. As you can see from our weekly collections update, our donations are down approximately 25%, which will significantly impact our ability to break even this year. We anticipate a loss of approximately \$33,000 this year, which unfortunately will have to be funded through our limited reserves if we are unable to make this deficit up. We encourage anyone who has not attended one of the weekend Masses to continue to include us in their gifting for 2020. Parishioners who would like to have their contributions earmarked for the roof can mark on envelope "FOR ROOF ONLY" and drop off at Monastery or mail to us or contribute online. Please note that any Project Advance donations to Sacred Heart Parish – Delta for the balance of 2020 will be returned to the parish to help defray the roofing costs. The roof project was deferred from 2018 and was unable to be deferred any further due to some significant water damage anticipated if not replaced.
