Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

*The smallest seed becomes the greatest
of all shrubs. Mark 4.26-34*

Sunday Reflection: The seed of faith is in our hearts, and grace helps it to bear fruit. Jesus speaks his Word to the crowds in parables because that is how they were able to understand it. Today, he uses agrarian images. Although farming is dependent on many variables the farmer has no control over, the seed of faith planted on our hearts is totally in our control. Will we take the time to weed? Will we take the time to water? **LITURGY OF THE WORD** Ezekiel speaks for the Lord, who will take a shoot from a cedar and plant it on the mountain heights of Israel, where it will bear fruit. In the second reading, Paul writes that we walk by faith, not by sight. In the Gospel, Jesus describes the kingdom of God using parables of a wheat field and a mustard seed.
