

# Project Advance Fall Campaign is Underway!

The annual Project Advance appeal provides critical funding to key ministries and projects in our Archdiocese as well as to our parish. Last year our parish raised \$62,000, which was \$16,000 beyond our parish assessment of \$46,000. With this \$16,000 in funds, we were able to undertake necessary electrical work to refurbish our parish lighting.

This year our goal is \$80,000. Of that total, \$46,000 will go towards Archdiocesan programs through our annual assessment, and \$34,000 will be shared equally in projects to improve our parish accessibility and our Liturgy of the Word for Children program.

We hope that everyone will participate in this year's appeal. Starting in November one of our Finance Committee members will be at the back of the church after all Masses should you require any assistance with making your donation or you can visit projectadvance.ca.
