Sunday Reflection: Prepare for the coming of the Lord. Today's readings speak to us of preparing for the coming of the Lord through repentance. Repentance requires us to be honest about the times we have fallen short in loving God and our neighbor as the Lord commands. Knowing that we are sinners is a necessary step in recognizing our need for the forgiveness God has graciously offered us through his Son, whose coming into the world we prepare to celebrate. LITURGY OF THE WORD Isaiah offers words of comfort and hope that the time of exile is coming to an end and the Lord is preparing to reveal his glory to all people. Peter exhorts his community to live in holiness and devotion in anticipation of the day of the Lord. Mark begins his Gospel describing the ministry of John the Baptist who proclaimed a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins, and that one greater than he would come and baptize with the Holy Spirit. <u>Simbang Gabi Masses</u> Our parish along with parishes in Richmond will celebrate Simbang Gabi Masses in December.

"Simbang Gabi" is a tradition unlike any other. A Christmas Marian Novena of Masses, "Simbang Gabi" is a nine-day devotion that honours the Annunciation, the expectation of the Blessed Virgin Mary, and culminating in the birth of Jesus. Centered on the Eucharist, it is a combination of deep prayer, community spirit, reconciliation, hope, love, and the grateful recognition of our redemption.

By God's Grace, we can hope based on a Promise: Advent is the anticipation of the coming of our Saviour Jesus Christ, the Light that will lead us out of darkness.

In this very same Light, we invite all faithful to celebrate this Promise of Salvation, by attending the Nine-Day Novena Masses ("Simbang Gabi".)

Following Filipino Christmas and Advent traditions, the "Parol" (Christmas Lantern) Procession and the "Panuluyan" (Christmas Eve Play) will preface the evening's celebration.


